Débora Sánchez Viqueira is a designer, artist and interior architect born in Buenos Aires, Argentina, and has lived in Madrid, Spain, since 2002. Her training in Interior Architecture and Design in Buenos Aires marked the beginning of a creative career that combines Design, Art and innovative techniques.

From childhood, her connection with art developed in the workshops of renowned Argentinean masters, where she gained extensive knowledge and skill in various materials and techniques. This strong foundation enabled her artistic evolution in both Argentina and Spain, through numerous art and design projects.

In 2002, she founded Miyabi Casa, where she currently serves as Creative Director. Through painting and digital art, she has brought to life textile collections that have been showcased at major international events, including Maison et Objet (Paris), ICFF (New York), BDNY (New York), and Salone del Mobile (Milan). These collections are now featured in numerous studios and galleries across Europe, the Middle East, Asia, and the United States, cementing her global reach.

With over 25 years in the artistic field, her work has evolved from pure expressionism to the abstract expressionism that defines her current style. In her most recent pieces, the influence of her architectural and design training is evident, especially in her creation of textures and three-dimensional spaces using her own techniques. By blending painting and organic forms, she achieves a distinctive three-dimensional effect.

Her current work explores mixed techniques, with color playing a central role in highlighting shapes and volumes. Inspired by the four elements of nature - water, air, fire, and earth - and the human figure, her pieces connect matter and its manifestations, creating textures that bridge pictorial and sculptural art.

Her work has been exhibited in prestigious galleries and art fairs both in Spain and internationally, standing out in events such as the Estampa Contemporary Art Fair (Spain), Art Montpellier (France), International Contemporary Art Fair (Monaco), Santa Catalina Palace (St. Petersburg, Russia) and Miami Art Basel Week (United States), among others.

“UNEXPECTED”

“Unexpected” explores the connection between the construction of human forms and the reinterpretation of cubism in a contemporary language.

This series evokes the unexpected in the female figure, integrating mixed techniques - pictorial and textile art - to emphasize the fusion between the classical and the handmade, the material and the symbolic.

The eye, present in all the works, acts as a leitmotif symbolizing introspection, vigilance and the universality of human experience. Its repetition suggests a deep connection between the pieces, inviting the viewer to reflect on perception and the gaze, both internal and external.

Cubism, which emerged in the early twentieth century, was characterized by the fragmentation of reality through geometric shapes, decomposing objects and figures to offer multiple simultaneous perspectives. This series takes up those principles, adapting them to a current vision that incorporates the female figure as the central axis. Geometric shapes are used to reconstruct female bodies, exploring identity and perception from a contemporary perspective.

The combination of painting and embroidery in the works pays homage to traditional craftsmanship, especially textile art, historically associated with the feminine and often this craft relegated in the artistic sphere. This integration seeks to elevate these techniques, recognizing their aesthetic and symbolic value, and highlighting the richness of the craft tradition in contemporary art.

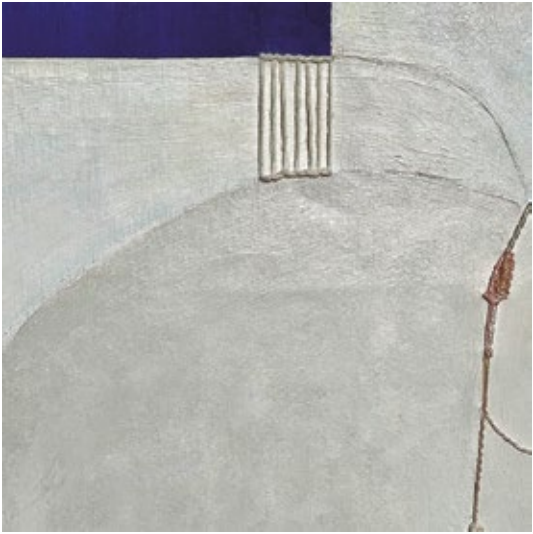
“Unexpected” offers a renewed vision of cubism, fusing geometric elements with the representation of femininity and artisanal techniques. The series invites a reflection on perception, identity and the connection between the traditional and the contemporary in Art.

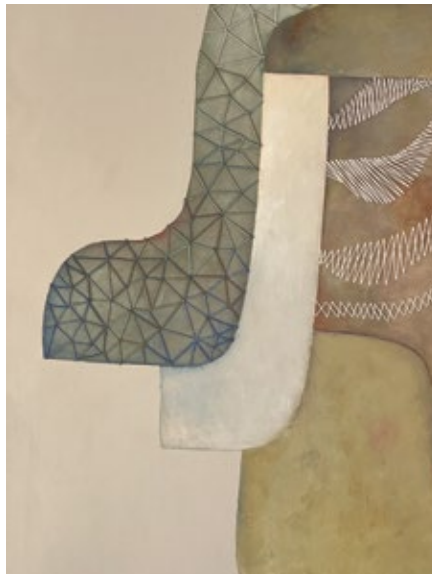

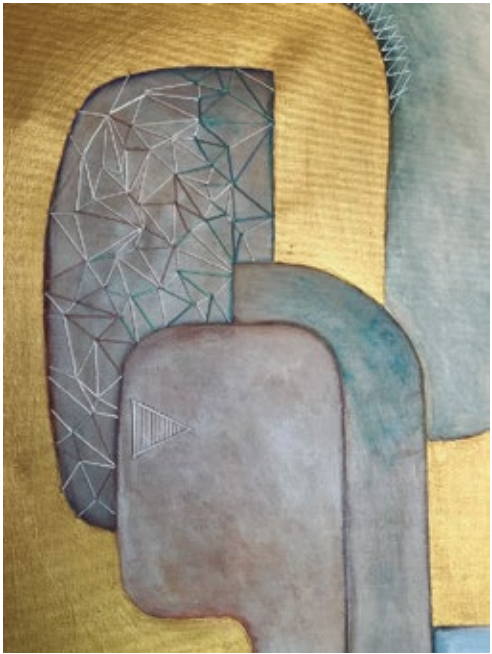

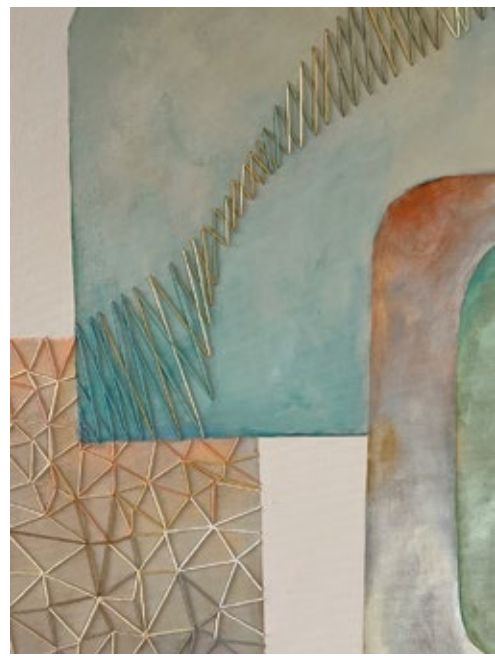
